





Accessibility

iPad comes standard with accessibility features that help people with disabilities experience all that it has to offer.

Built-in accessibility.

iPad comes with a screen reader, support for playback of closed-captioned content, and other innovative universal access features - right out of the box. There's no additional software to buy or install. These features make iPad easier to use for people who have a vision impairment, are deaf or hard of hearing, or have a physical or learning disability.

VoiceOver

- Standard feature on iPhones, iPads, and iTouches
- World's first gesturebased screen reader
- DOES NOT WORK WITH
 ALL APPS
 - Does not work with many ebooks or textbooks
- Built-in voices that speak36 languages

- Adjustable speaking rate
- Echoes each character as you touch it when typing or can speak completed word instead.
- Speak Auto-text
- Has the rotor
- Works with all built-in applications



Helpful tips for VoiceOver

- Settings => General => Accessibility => Voice
 Over
- Adjust settings if needed
- Touch screen to hear description of item and the double- tap to open
- Use VoiceOver with pictures to tell who is in them
- Trip tap screen to activate screen curtain
 - Privacy



Helpful tips for VoiceOver

- The Rotor
 - Virtual control
 - Rotating 2 fingers on the screen like a dial
 - Changes the way VO moves through a document based on setting
 - Can use to navigate through web pages



Zoom/ White on Black

- Zoom
 - Magnify entire screen of any application
 - Double-tap with 3 fingers
 - Can magnify 100%-500%
 - Does not work with VoiceOver on
- White on Black
 - Reverse video effect works in all applications
 - Can be used with Zoom and VoiceOver



More...

- Tactile buttons
 - Easily discernible buttons
- Large Text








Hearing

- Mono Audio
- Custom Vibrations
 - On iPhone
 - Assign unique vibrations patterns
 - Change default in Sounds setting
 - Create you own custom vibrations
 - Save and name it
- LED Flash for Alerts
- Answer calls in Speaker Mode or Headset
 - Accessibility=> Incoming Calls
- Visual Voicemails
- TTY mode.
- FaceTime
 - Use in Wifi
- Closed Captioning
 - Supports playback of open captions, closed captions, and subtitling





Assistive Touch

- Lets you enter Multi-Touch gestures using one finger or stylus
 - Create custom gestures
- Supports the use of adaptive input devices
 - Headsets and switches
- Change Tracking Speed






Creating Keyboard Shortcuts

- Go to General => Keyboard and make sure Shortcut is turned on
- Go to Add New Shortcut
- Put in your Phrase
- Create Short Cut
- Example:
 - Phrase : Martha E. Rust, MS CRC
 - Shortcut is: MER
 - So when I type MER it will put in the above Phrase
 - OMW => On My Way!



Reader feature for Websites

- Read articles without distractions.
- Clutter disappears
- Add link into Reading List and finish later





Types of Reading Apps

- There are over 27,000 reading apps and over 500,000 books and publications
- Active Reading Apps
 - Studies show that comprehension improves by 38%-70%
 - Defined as eyes are on the screen following the words
 - Highlighting of words, sentences, and paragraphs
- Passive Reading App
 - No pictures
 - Usually synthetic Computer Generated Voices/ VoiceOver

Low Tech Way to Create Enlarged Books with Pictures

- Use Built in Camera to Take Pictures of Book
- Go to Built in Photo App- Select pictures and create an album that has those pictures shot in order. Save album with te name of the book.
- Use expand two finger gesture to enlarge and move around the picture and text.



- Prototype app for touchscreen mobile devices
- FREE Open Source app
- 32 words per minute with 92% accuracy with the prototype app for the iPhone

- Braille like typing












More Apps...Note Taking

• SoundNote- is the best way to take notes in meetings, lectures, and interviews. It tracks what you type and draw while recording audio, so you'll never worry about missing an important detail. During playback, just tap a word: SoundNote will jump right to the proper time in the audio



Memory, writing...

 Voice Memo: Capture a thought, a memo, a meeting, or any audio recording with Voice Memos. When you're done, edit your recording, then send it via email or MMS.

• Evernote (or Dropbox): Evernote gives users the ability to remember any and every little thing that one might need. A user can write notes, take snapshots, and even do recordings. App allows users the ability to sync with Mac or Windows. Evernote is known for its geo-mapping feature for location and search. The app is free for use.



Memory, organize...

Remember the Milk.

Remember the Milk is a free iPhone app for organization that is based on the website of the same name. Bring your "To-Do" list to life with features such as keys, tasks, actions, search, notes, locations, and reminders. App allows user to switch to landscape mode for easier reading and typing.



Communication / Hearing

• **Sign 4 Me-** 3D character can be zoomed in or out and rotated to give you the best vantage point for every sign. The library includes more than 11,500 words. Type in sentences, phrases, words and even the alphabet. Everything you enter will be saved in your History.


