## The Need for Alternative Funding

- Funding is the greatest barrier for individuals with disabilities to acquire assistive technology
- Third party funding sources are not increasing and their eligibility criteria are narrowing
- Traditional credit financing for assistive technology has not been available for individuals with disabilities





#### What to do when someone needs AT?

- Many agencies are "payers of last resort"
- Develop an AT Funding Plan
- Determine which equipment is needed as a medical necessity, which is needed for educational purposes, which is needed to reach vocational goals.
- There is no agency that can pay for all AT -Leverage and toggle all resources!

# Georgia's Alternative Financing Program for Assistive Technology







## **Credit-Able Program Criteria**



#### To receive a Credit-Able Loan you must be:

A resident of Georgia

AND

- An individual with a disability OR
- A family member or legal guardian of an individual with a disability OR
- An employer of an individual with a disability
- Able to pay back the loan
- Using the loan to buy assistive technology equipment and services



## Range of Loans, Terms, and Interest Rates



- Range of Loans Approved: \$250 to \$50,000
- Length of Loans Approved: 6 months to 8 years
- Interest Rates: 5.0 % 9.0 %





## **YOU Save Money!**



### **Traditional Financing**

- \$2,000
- 22% (rate of average credit card)
- 3 year term
- Monthly payment = \$76.38
- Total interest paid = \$749.71

### **Credit-Able Financing**

- \$2,000
- 5.4%
- 3 year term
- Monthly payment = \$60.30
- Total interest paid = \$170.86

**Total interest saved: \$578.85** 



## **The Bottom Line – Consumers Save Money and Build Credit!**



### **Traditional Financing**

- \$25,000
- 12.9% interest
- 6 year term
- Monthly payment = \$500.53
- Interest Paid = \$11,038.46

### **Credit-Able Financing**

- \$25,000
- 5% interest
- 6 year term
- Monthly payment = \$402.62
- Interest Paid = \$3,988.88

Interest SAVED over the life of the loan: \$7,049.58




## Telecommunications Equipment Distribution Program

- Meet income eligibility requirements for your household size
- Be certified by a healthcare professional as deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind or speech disabled.
- Have phone service in your home.
- Be a resident of that state and at least five years old.





# **Georgia Lions Lighthouse**

- Eyeglasses and Exams
- The Lions Lighthouse has a mobile clinic that visits 23 sites throughout Georgia. At each clinic, qualifying individuals can receive eye exams and glasses.
- Full dilated eye exam (performed by either an ophthalmologist or optometrist).
- One pair of eyeglasses every 3 years.
- Follow-up care for chronic eye conditions

### **Rural Home & Home Mod Loans**

### **USDA** Rural Development

www.rurdev.usda.gov/ga

- Section 502 loans are primarily used to help low-income individuals or households purchase homes in rural areas.
- Funds can be used to build, repair, renovate or relocate a home, or to purchase and prepare sites, including providing water and sewage facilities.
- Applicants for loans may have an income of up to 115% of the median income for the area.
- Families must be without adequate housing, but be able to afford the mortgage payments, including taxes and insurance.
- Applicants must have reasonable credit history

- Displacement: Lodging, food, gas, parking and transportation for families of seriously ill children who must travel during treatment
- Vehicle modifications: Lifts, ramps and transfer boards








- Focus on returning to an active lifestyle
  - Sports (Quad rugby, basketball, fencing, racing)
- Try before buy
  - Closet with sports equipment
  - Rental program
  - Long- term loan of equipment while playing
- Do not have to be a current patient







# **Rental Programs**

- Individuals can try before making a huge purchase
- \$10/day or \$25 for weekend
- Written Rental Agreement
  - Responsible for equipment
  - Demonstrates the use

# **Long-Term Loans**

- Athletes that play sports
  - Quad rugby, basketball, fencing, etc
- Athletes are responsible for equipment
  - Tubes for tires
  - Minor repairs
  - Funds for major repairs
- Athletes are responsible for additional items for the sport
  - Gloves, tape, cushions, etc
- Bring back at end of season
- Shepherd cleans and sanitizes after each rental and loan




# **Blaze Sports**

Mission: Driven by a desire to provide all children and adults with physical disabilities the chance to play sports and live healthy, active lives.

- Money for equipment chairs came from Department of Labor in Georgia when first started
- 26 different Sport programs
  - Geared mostly towards children and teens
  - There is some equipment for adults







# **Blaze Equipment Loan Program**

- No Fees to loan/ borrow equipment
  - Have to be a member of Blaze
  - Fill out written loan agreement form
  - Come in for chair fitting and skills assessment
  - Sign written waiver
- Will loan to groups that have teams
  - Rockdale County, Albany, Augusta
  - Ft. Stewart: basketball chairs for military team








# **Blaze Equipment Loan Program**

- Athletes are responsible for other equipment needed
  - Cushions, tapes, gloves, etc
- Blaze monitors and maintains equipment while in use
  - 6 months to a year
  - Funds for major repairs


