Access GA

As a joint initiative of the State of Georgia ADA Coordinator's Office, Center for Inclusive Design & Innovation, and the Georgia Technology Authority (GTA), AccessGA supports Georgia's more than 75 state agencies with ICT accessibility and promotes equal and timely access for employees and customers with a wide range of disabilities. In August of 2016, Georgia Technology Authority, though its partnership with AccessGA, was recognized by GA's Governor Nathan Deal for its statewide impact, including the launch of 13 accessible website templates used throughout the state. In 2018, Georgia's State Government websites ranked 2nd best in the nation in accessibility.

WAG, Web Accessibility Group

An initiative that brings together individuals in higher education seeking to navigate the complex Section 508 standards and Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0/2.1 to advance user experience design and enhance user satisfaction by improving the usability and accessibility of college and university websites and applications.

AccessText Network

90,000 requests for publisher files per year. Requests are placed from over 2,900 post-secondary Disability Services Offices. AccessText now includes 43 memberpublishers. Publishers have stored over 50,000 files for automatic fulfillment of 61% of annual requests.

Student Accommodation Manager

A secure, web-based database application that helps postsecondary Disability Service offices manage student accommodation and disability data, case notes, and much more.
