

### **Technology Changes Fast**

- June 2007- 1st iPhone
- Sept 2007- 1<sup>st</sup> generation iPod Touch
- October 2008- 1<sup>st</sup> Android phone sold
- April 2010- 1<sup>ST</sup> iPad
- 2010- Google launched its Nexus series of tablets and smartphones
- 50 billion downloads!



### **Statistics**

 There are approximately 73 million iPhones in the world.

# **AAC** Evaluation Genie



- informal diagnostic tool that is intended to assist speechlanguage pathologists and others
- does not to identify a particular speech generating device, but rather build a framework for selecting an appropriate augmentative communication device for ongoing evaluation and / or device trial
- ability to visually track and identify a single icon from 5" to 1" in size.





#### **Aphasia Facts**

- Major cause in US is stroke ~700,000 strokes/year
- New aphasia cases per year ~100,000 (ALS ~5,000; CP ~10,000)
- Currently ~1,000,000 Americans living with aphasia
- Year 2020 prevalence of aphasia projected: ~2,000,000
- Why: aging US population, more stroke survivors, living longer




# AAC Comparison Chart: South Carolina AT Program





It should be used in conjunction with more comprehensive checklists that address a variety of app features, such as those developed by <u>Gosnell</u> (2011) and <u>Marfilius and Fonner</u> (2012). When selecting AAC apps for an individual, this rubric should be used in the context of a comprehensive AAC evaluation, which considers a range of strategies and tools. 
