


Diving Beneath the Surface: A Closer Look at Tablets, Apps and Accessibility


Considering Ergonomics

What is **Ergonomics**



- Greek word: Laws of Work
- Science that studies work in various environments, and the tools used to perform tasks in those environments
- Goal: match the capabilities and "limitations" of the human body







When is an evaluation needed



- Proactive/Prevention
- When working posture is affecting performance, attention, and creating pain
- **TIP:** Consider incorporating ergonomic principles into the IEP to support educational goals.
 - Helps with breathing, circulation, attention, concentration & ultimately learning
 - Must consult with a trained professional
 - Educate everyone student, family, teachers, parapros

New electronic tattoos could help monitor health during normal daily activities.

Taking advantage of recent advances in flexible electronics, researchers have devised a way to "print" devices directly onto the skin so people can wear them for an extended period while performing normal daily activities. Such systems could be used to track health and monitor healing near the skin's surface, as in the case of surgical wounds.

So-called "epidermal electronics" were demonstrated previously in <u>research</u> from the lab of <u>uchn Robers</u>, a materials scientist at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, the devices consist of ultrathin electrodes, electronics, sensors, and wireless power and communication systems. In theory, they could attach to the skin and record and transmit electrophysiological measurements for

These early versions of the technology, which were designed to be applied to a thin, soft elastomer backing, were "fine for an office environment," says Rogers, "but if you wanted to go swimming or take a shower they weren't able to hold up." Now, Rogers and his coworkers have figured out how to grint the electronics right on the skin, making the device more durable and rugged.



"What we've found is that you don't even need the elastomer backing," Rogers says. "You can use a rubber stamp to just deliver the ultrathin mesh electronics directly to the surface of the skin." The researchers also found that they could use commercially available "spray-on bendage" products to add a thin protective layer and bond the system to the skin in a "very robust way," he says.

Eliminating the elastomer backing makes the device

Side algorithe This device, applied directly to the skin, can record castul medical information. one-thirtleth as thick, and thus "more conformal to the kind of roughness that's present naturally on the surface of the skin," says Rogers. It can be worn for up to two weeks before the skin's natural exteriation process causes it to flake off.



During the two weeks that it's attached, the device can measure things like temperature, strain, and the hydration state of the skin, all of which are useful in tracking general health and wellness. One specific application could be to monitor wound healing: if a doctor or nurse attached the system near a surgical wound before the patient left the hospital, it could take measurements and transmit the information whelessly to the health-care providers.






Layout of Surface

What Is Android?

- AMAC Accessibility for All
- Android is an operating system based on the Linux kernel with a user interface based on direct manipulation, designed primarily for touchscreen mobile devices such as smartphones and tablet computers, using touch inputs, that loosely correspond to real-world actions, like swiping, tapping, pinching, and reverse pinching to manipulate on-screen objects, and a virtual keyboard. Despite being primarily designed for touchscreen input, it also has been used in televisions, games consoles, digital cameras, and other electronics.
- As of 2011, Android has the largest installed base of any mobile OS and as of 2013, its devices also sell more than Windows, iOS and Mac OS devices combined.
- As of July 2013 the Google Play store has had over 1 million Android apps published, and over 50 billion apps downloaded.





Number of Android smartphone users in the United States from 2010 to 2014 (in millions)



The Sense UI affects fewer of the phone's applications than the Touchwiz overlay on some Samsung phones, but Sense does require users to find some extra know-how or workarounds for certain things: the accessibility option in settings, the unlock gestures, the stock launcher, the call answer/reject/end gestures, the in-call screen, and the Contacts, Messaging, Alarms, and camera apps. Don't worry, most of this is still usable.

Voters in the three states questioned in the Quinnipiac survey said they saw Obama as better for handling the economy, health care, Medicare, national security, international crisis and immigration. Romney tied or edged ahead on dealing with the budget deficit.
