

Telework Platform Accessibility Matrix

About the Features in the Matrix

- **Dial-in Conference Line vs. Video Meetings** – describes how the participants communicate
 - Video meetings allow participants to read lips or watch a sign language interpreter.
 - Dial-in conference lines use less bandwidth and might be easier to access from mobile devices.
- **Screen Share Slides / Other** – the presenter can share presentation slides during a meeting
 - Some platforms also provide the ability to share other documents / screen views.
 - Use screen sharing to guide employees through setting up software / using access features.
- **Live Chat** – chat box between team members
 - Employees who have difficulty speaking can use this feature to ask/answer typed questions.
 - It may not be compatible with the employee's screen reading or assistive typing software.
- **Notes/Whiteboard** – allows participants to collaborate in real time on a document, picture, plan, etc.
- **Raise Hand** – signal to the presenter
 - Employees who have difficulty jumping into a conversation quickly can indicate that they have something to say.
- **Control Participant Mics** – the meeting host can mute everyone's mics or to delegate who can speak
- **Record Session** – record the meeting
 - In addition to allowing employees who missed the meeting find out what occurred, this also provides an alternative for notetaking during a meeting.
- **Scheduler** – sends out a meeting time for calendars when the meeting is created
 - This feature is particularly helpful for employees who have difficulty with time management and/or organization.
- **Keyboard Control** – allows the user to use keyboard shortcuts / hot keys to control meeting features (e.g., using Ctrl-M to mute your mic.)
 - Most platforms have this feature. It is essential for employees who can't use a mouse.
- **Automatic / External Captioning** – features that support captioning for people who are deaf, hard of hearing, or who are not auditory learners
 - Automatic captioning uses artificial intelligence to generate the captions. Nothing more needs to be done by the meeting host, but the accuracy will not be 100%. Thus, it might be good enough for a project meeting; not good enough for education, legal proceedings or finances.
 - External captioning uses a live person to generate captions through a link or directly on the platform. The accuracy will be much better, but it requires advance planning and expense.
- **Supports Interpreter** – setting so that a sign language interpreter's video screen remains on view (is pinned (specific user) or spotlighted (all attendees)) during the entire meeting
- **Interface Complexity** – How difficult is the platform to use?
 - Consider whether there are tutorials and whether the interface is it fairly self-explanatory.
 - Look for controls that stay in view and have redundant indication of what they do (text, icons).

somewhat complex
