



Technology Changes Fast

What We Know

- Test Scores influence key decisions in education
 - Common Core Standards
- Accommodations are usually after the fact
- Accommodations are:
 - Intended to reduce or eliminate the effects of a student's disability
 - Do not reduce learning expectations
 - Level playing field, not provide undue advantages




- Majority of students with Learning Disabilities have reading disabilities
 - (Shaywitz, 2003)
- Even as they progress and get older, students with learning disabilities may read more accurately with more automaticity however are likely to remain slow readers and benefit from extra time
 - (Gregg, Mather, Shaywitz, 2003)

Research

- Research show that having items read aloud can improve fluency and comprehension
- Text Readers
 - Increase word recognition, speed of reading and comprehension
 - Increase the amount read, reduce distractibility
 - (Hecker, Burns, Elkind, Elkind, and Katz, 2002)

PAR: Protocol for Accommodations for Reading

- Don Johnston
- Assist with accommodations for reading
- 3 Steps
 - 1) Student's Oral Reading
 - 2) Adult Reader
 - 3) Text Reader
- How did the student like?
- Help with adding in AT for reading solutions



What is E-Text?

- Any text-based information that is available in a digitally encoded human-readable format
- Can be read by electronic means
- May be an electronic edition of a work originally composed or published in other media, or may be created in electronic form originally

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

 - At its conception A used to mean Audio
- Digital Talking Book (DTB) specification for accessible digital textbooks
- Internationally recognized accessible multi-media publishing system, compatible with the World Wide Web

Learning Disabilities and Writing

- Dysgraphia- affects writing, which requires a complex set of motor and information processing skills
 - Poor Handwriting
 - Spelling
 - Organizing Thoughts
- Dyslexia- language processing disorder can hinder reading, writing, spelling and sometimes even speaking
- Executive Functioning- governs the ability to plan, organize and manage details
- Auditory processing disorder can cause difficulty in distinguishing the difference between similar sounds




Ginger
